Building Checklist

Before you start new construction or a major building project, your HOA application and Road Damage Deposit must be received. Please read and follow these basic rules and return a signed copy to the Board. Following these rules will protect you and all of your neighbors from any inconvenience and unexpected damage.

- 1. Post one sign on your property with street address and contractor's name which is visible from the street.
- 2. Provide on-site restroom facilities.
- 3. Provide on-site garbage cans.
- 4. Install culvert of proper size to allow water to run freely (approx length = 20 feet; approximately pipe diameter = 10-20 inches depending on building site).
- 5. Cut in a driveway such that all contractors' park vehicles off the main road and equipment is unloaded and loaded off the main road.
- Put gravel on the driveway sufficient to have no construction tracking from your site to the main road. (You might have to add more gravel during the course of construction.)
- The owner of each lot shall be responsible for soil erosion, dust control (water during grading as needed) and other damages to the road, except for normal wear and tear.
- 8. Place two 10'x4' or 8'x4' steel plates between private driveway and subdivision road to prevent damage to this encroachment section of the road.
- 9. Each owner will manage their contractors and sub-contractors to ensure quick response to violations, disruption and damages to subdivision.
- 10. Give copy of this checklist to contractor, prior to project initiation.
- 11. Construction trucks must NOT make U-Turns on any Court or Cul-de-sac inside the community. They MUST back out ONLY.
- 12. These rules and regulations do not supersede or change the Bylaws or Declaration of Restrictions in any manner. They do have the same status of law and enforceability.
